

Tracking Out-of-Pocket Expenses

An out-of-pocket expense counts towards the maximum dollar amount that a covered person must pay during a defined benefit period.

How can I track my out-of-pocket expenses?

- 1. Register¹ or login at express-scripts.com.
- 2. Select "Claims & Balances" from the menu under Prescriptions.
- On the Claims & balances page, 'Benefit plan balances' tab, click "view details" next to Out of Pocket (see below) to display your out-of-pocket expense details to date.





You can view other plan balances, such as Deductible, by clicking 'view details' by each item.

What are my maximum out-of-pocket expenses this year?

Benefit Highlights provides a plan overview, including out-of-pocket expenses, if applicable to your plan. To view, select "Benefits Overview" from the menu under Benefits (see right).
